

A Community Clinic in the Jungle

In 2018 Finding Freedom through Friendship provided medications for a rural Guatemalan jungle clinic that takes place in Zona Reina. The clinician (Sally York, missionary residing in Guatemala) who dispensed the FFF donated medications saw 800 patients during ten monthly visits to this geographical area from February 2018 through December 2018. Ten percent of the patients were men, 40% women and 50% children under the age of 10. There is a high birth rate in this area, which has resulte in several malnourished mothers and babies.

This donation cost our organization \$1,000 in 2018. The impact of this community project was large indeed. There is no other health clinic available for many miles from this jungle village. A typical prescription would consist of antibiotics, anti-inflammatories, medications for gastritis and vitamins for all age groups.

This donation was transformational in the well-being of the residents in the Zona Reina area.
